The partnership of keyboardist Tom Alexander & drummer Tommy G. Lee, known together as Earth Code, continues to bear the most wondrous fruit. Much like the creative team of Steely Dan's Walter Becker & Donald Fagen – or to be more genre specific – that of Danny Gottlieb & Mark Egan of the influential fusion group Elements, the two gather great musicians to help explore their latest ideas & record them for posterity.

Earth Code's last expedition, Tones from the Middle Distance, was a tour de force of world fusion music that should be in everyone's collection. Idiom is no different, but it is. Lee & Alexander have added a good number of dramatic extra-musical atmospherics. These effects provide context for the pieces which may or may not be guided by that context. Such is the nature of this idiom.

Lee & Alexander are master musicians whose creative juices flow over any brims trying to contain them. For most of the cuts, they are joined by guitarist Tomati & bassists Rusty Heck, Shawn Saul or Emilio Martinez. Martinez also sang, layered & arranged the vocal choirs & recorded the album. Each, & all other guest players, are fantastic if not downright revelatory.

Most of the compositions are by Alexander, though others contribute some numbers & there is a cover. Alexander is a great admirer of the late Chick Corea & Lyle Mays. You will hear that.

Once you enter Earth Code's universe of blues, rock, straight-ahead & progressive jazz & world music awash in the cultural undertones of Brazil, Africa, the Mediterranean & half the world, you will want to extend your stay.

If you are moved by the music of Weather Report, Chick Corea, Lyle Mays, Mahavishnu, Snarky Puppy, Jeff Beck or Domi and JD Beck – you will be overjoyed with Earth Code's Idiom.
